Norfolk Island was first discovered by Captain Cook on October 10, 1774. In the latter part of the 18th century, Lieutenant King founded a penal colony. In 1825 the second and most barbarous settlement was established. It was virtually an island of horror until 1855 when the prisoners were transferred to Tasmania. There are many relics which testify to the hideous hangings, murders and daring escapes. In 1856 the descendants of the "Bounty" arrived from Pitcairn. This marked the turning point in Norfolk's history. A new era began, changing Norfolk from a veritable hell on earth to a Pacific paradise.
