The Penguin Islands are a string of 13 penguin islands situated along the west coast of Southern Africa, off the Republic of Namibia. They were annexed by the British in the mid-18th century as part of the Cape Province (now part of the RSA). They therefore predate Namibia as an administrative entity. They are currently protected as nature reserves. We operated from Penguin Island, in Luderitz Bay ($26^{\circ}37'5.615S\ 15^{\circ}0E$). The island is about 1500 x 600 m, and our one tower was mounted at its peak (45 m above). The island is visited by many thousands of guillemots, and a number of cormorants. There is almost no vegetation - a few small buildings from an old guillemot mine still stand on the western side. We erected four rotatable Yaesu antennas and three independent stations while on the island. The WARC band signal was radiated by an All-in-one beam supplied by Cushcraft. The 10m monobander was supplied by NCDXF for the previous ZS6EZ/251 operation. The low band antenna was the same Blame Green Spreader used at 2Y1SX, and made available courtesy of W6GCD, WB6VZ and K4QG through the NCDFX. QRPtronics kindly supplied 700m of RG-213 at cost. An attempt was made to try extensive coverage to Europe and Japan (where the bands have remained high on wanted lists) as well as both low bands and WARC bands. In spite of inconstant conditions, these goals were met. Over 140 non-African stations were worked on 160 m alone.

NCDXF came through yet again with major financial support. Other contributors include 712HPT, WHUR and ZS6MSK. K4YMM, WB2VZ, ZS4WWS, ZS4DXF came through again with major financial support.
